**Fee for Service:**

**Local coordination:** A local entity can host the training at a cost of \$500 per half-day session, plus expenses. MNA provides materials for local reproduction; local host coordinates all registrations and site logistics. Local host may charge participants a registration fee if they wish.

**MNA coordination:** MNA will coordinate registration and provide all materials; local host assists with logistical coordination and promotion. MNA will charge individual participants a standard training rate.
