Michigan Nonprofit Association Awards 2017-18 AmeriCorps VISTA Host Sites

LANSING, Michigan - The Michigan Nonprofit Association AmeriCorps VISTA program today announced the awardees for its 2017-18 host sites. These host sites - college campuses, K-12 schools, or nonprofit organizations affiliated with MNA - will receive one or two AmeriCorps VISTA members for a one-year term. AmeriCorps VISTA members use their skills, talents and passion to support community efforts to overcome poverty.

“AmeriCorps VISTA has been on the forefront of ending poverty in America for 50 years,” said Maggie Harris, AmeriCorps VISTA Program Manager at Michigan Nonprofit Association. “MNA is proud to be a sponsoring organization. This is just one of the many ways we support nonprofits to achieve their missions.”

AmeriCorps VISTA is open to all U.S. citizens, nationals, or lawful permanent resident aliens age 18 and older. Members and summer associates receive a modest living allowance. Members who serve for a year also receive limited health benefit options, childcare, if needed, and other benefits.
